- (1) It is the policy of the State Board of Community Colleges and of the Board of Trustees of Roanoke-Chowan Community College not to discriminate among students on the basis of race, gender, national origin, religion, age, or disability.
- (2) The Board of Trustees shall give equal opportunity for employment and compensation of personnel at Roanoke-Chowan Community College without regard to race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age, or disability, except where specific age, sex, or physical or mental requirements constitute bona fide occupational qualifications. The College shall seek to employ women and minorities in administrative positions.
- (3) The College shall comply with the provisions of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and other acts banning discrimination because of race, national origin, color, religion, sex, disability, age, or political affiliation.
- (4) The President shall assign the equal opportunity function to a college employee to ensure that this policy is implemented.
