- (1) The Bertie County Board of Education permits selected high school students to be admitted to appropriate courses in a technical institute or community college under the following conditions:
 - (1.1) Student must be 16 years of age or older.
 - (1.2) Student must successfully be taking at least three courses or three units of work at the high school and maintain these courses.
 - (1.3) The total number of students enrolled in the community college system may not exceed five percent of the total enrollment in the high school.
 - (1.4) The student must complete an application for dual enrollment which contains at least the following:
 - (1.4.1) Student’s name
 - (1.4.2) Time requested to attend community college
 - (1.4.3) Courses requested to be taken
 - (1.4.4) Approval signature of parent or legal guardian
 - (1.4.5) Approval signature of high school counselor, high school principal, and superintendent
 - (1.4.6) Approval signature of Dean of Student Services of the participating community college
 - (1.5) Students will be expected to meet all requirements and standards in both the high school and community college in which they plan to enroll.
