She stated she recently met with Golden Leaf, and they have agreed to a one year no cost extension. The UTTC Grant was designed to serve 50 people and the College has exceeded this amount.
- The SNAP Grant has been utilized as well and has serviced 35 students in the Rich Square location in EMS and the Nurses Aid Program. The grant will expire next year.
