

2017 Graduate Survey Highlights

- Programs with the largest number of graduates include Associate in Arts (17), Criminal Justice (7) Associate Degree Nursing (6), Cosmetology (6), Medical Office Technology (5), and Human Services Technology – Mental Health (4).
- 31 of 65 students accomplished their goal of earning an Associate Degree, diploma, or certificate.
- 19 of 65 students have been accepted to a 4-year college or university, including East Carolina University, Liberty University, Elizabeth City State University, UNC-Pembroke, UNC-Chapel Hill, Bennet College, Capella University, UNC-Greensboro, William Peace College, and Winston-Salem State University.
- 21 out of 65 students have accepted employment at various companies/agencies including Roanoke Electric Cooperative, Vidant Medical Center, Halifax Regional Hospital, Ellen's Hair Affair, Vidant- Bertie Memorial Hospital, Southeastern Cable, Sure Care Health Services, Perdue Farms, and Christopher John's Salon.
- 43 of 65 students would choose to attend R-CCC if they were to begin again.
- 64 of 65 students either completely accomplished their goals or partially completed their goals.
- Overall, most students were satisfied or very satisfied with services in various areas.
