ADDITIONAL ALLIED HEALTH ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

NURSE AIDE I

- A Background check is obtained through Castle Branch. Visit <u>www.castlebranch.com</u> and use the following code for ROANOKE CHOWAN COMMUNITY COLLEGE Nurse Aid I **KO41bg**
- The Background check and TB skin test *must be completed by the first day of class*.
- No Textbook is required for Nurse Aide I. The course information is through MOODLE. Moodle account information will be given on the first day of class.
- Students will present their Social Security Card and government IDs (Driver's License) to the instructor on the first day of class.
- The student that successfully completes the NA I Training will be eligible for the Nurse Aide North Carolina Competency Exam. The cost payable to Credentia is \$140.00. Information will be provided at the end of the course.

NURSE AIDE II

- A Criminal Background Check and Drug Screening are required for clinical rotation. To create an account through Castle Branch <u>www.castlebranch.com</u> The code for Nurse Aide II is **R70**.
- The student must complete the drug screening through Roanoke Chowan Community Health Center. Pay for the drug screening through Castle Branch. The student should take the receipt of payment for drug screening to RCCHC along with the Chain of Custody form given at the time of registration.
- Rotation Manager is an Online ECU HEALTH (RCH) clinical orientation manager system. Students will be given this information on the first day of class.
