## Earn the Executive Certificate in Ministry Leadership

### Introduction to Ministry Leadership (10 Hours)

August 16, 23, 30 (TH) 6:00-9:20 pm

In this course, students will receive an introduction to the basic leadership principles and an examination of trait, behavioral and contingency theories of leadership. Leadership theories are evaluated theologically. Biblical leadership aspects related to the church and denomination will be explored.

### Ministry Leadership (24 Hours)

September 4, 6, 11, 13, 18, 20, 25 (T and TH) 6:00-9:30 p.m.

This course will establish biblical principles and requirements for leadership while depicting biblical examples of how to develop leaders in ministry. Emphasis is placed on skill development, organizing, implementing ministerial programs and projects, and other related leadership skills.

### Strategic Communication (20 Hours)

October 4, 11, 18, 25 and November 1 (TH) 6:00-10:00 pm

This course enables students to develop communication strategies that help to achieve goals, including problem solving, team building, and developing and launching new programs or service. This course will provide methodologies on how to communicate across diverse sects of spiritual denominations.

### Organization Change/Conflict Resolution (20 Hours)

November 8, 15, 29, December 6, 13 (TH) 6:00-10:00 pm

This course provides an introduction of the principles and challenges of leading organizational change and managing conflict in churches and other spiritual institutions. Students will explore the role of leaders as change agents and in conflict resolution.
